Code of Conduct

1. All LCCA members participating in meetings will be treated with dignity, honoring their uniqueness and value. There will be no tolerance for discrimination in any form.
2. Public forum Member participants (ex: Board of Supervisor's Meetings, County Events, Volunteer Meetings, Social Media, etc) must represent the best interests of the LCCA & it's members, rather than individual constituencies. In cases where this is not possible, conflicts of interest must be declared at the outset of any discussions and the Member may be asked to refrain from interacting in such debates or events.
3. Members should not speak on behalf of the LCCA unless authorized to do so by the Executive Director or member of the Board.
4. Members shall not use the LCCA logo or name for personal business gain, advertisement, or otherwise without the written consent of the Board.
5. Members should make every effort to attend all meetings, complete necessary advance preparation for meetings, and be prepared to spend sufficient time and energy to LCCA needs & business.
6. Members should make every effort to arrive on time for meetings and stay for the duration of all meetings.
7. Regardless of their personal viewpoint, Member participants should not speak in a public forum (ex: Board of Supervisor's Meetings, Social Media, etc) if their opinion is

potentially inflammatory, offensive, or encouraging the engagement in illegal or illicit activities. Such actions can lead to membership suspension or revocation.

8. No personal attacks will be allowed on anyone, as this not only allows to deteriorate our solidarity and is unproductive and unprofessional.
9. No Member shall engage in slander or unethical business practices for personal gain.
10. All LCCA members are required to abide by all state and local laws. Should a member engage in illegal or illicit activities, their membership shall be suspended pending a Board decision. Should the board vote to revoke membership status, the member shall be notified via certified letter and shall not be reimbursed membership dues.
